First regional dialogue

Summary

Education and training is a key vehicle for bringing environmentally conscious knowledge and practices to farmers. A first exchange and networking meeting was held in Verden on September 24, 2019. The joint invitation with the Lower Saxony Chamber of Agriculture was accepted by various stakeholders from education and training.

In addition to getting to know each other and embedding in the project, there were first exciting discussion points that will be taken up further within the project. On the one hand, it became clear that there is already a high level of commitment and awareness for the topic of ammonia and methane emissions from agriculture among the participants. On the other hand, existing challenges and further opportunities for action, especially in the area of methane emissions, were clearly identified. - " What are the **obstacles and challenges** from the perspective of the stakeholders? What possibilities for action are seen? What assistance is needed?
- " What **political and/or structural framework conditions** are needed to adapt agricultural education and training?
- "How can **teaching content** for imparting knowledge on low-ammonia and low-methane farming look like? What is already being taught and what good practice examples exist?
